Bible: Matthew 3:13-4:11



30 PIECES OF SILVER DEVOTIONAL FOR LENT

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ: the early Christians observed with great devotion the days of our Lord's passion and resurrection, and it became the custom of the Church that before the Easter celebration there should be a forty-day season of spiritual preparation. The goal of Lenten worship is not better self-awareness but a deeper, more faithful commitment to the lordship of Christ---strengthening our spiritual life and experiencing spiritual renewal.

This year we are providing a way to help you to strengthen your spiritual life. It is called the 30 pieces of silver devotional. You will receive a letter with an outline for daily readings and "silver" offering bag. Each day you follow the outline and put a piece of silver in the bag. Bring the bag on Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday or Good Friday. Remember silver coins are nickels, dimes and quarters.

The 30 pieces of silver offering will be given to Door-Tran, which is a creative community network dedicated to connecting people to transportation services that are affordable, available, and accessible.

I know that some of you live away from Door County but you can still participate. You can give your offering at the church you attend away from here.
