Theme: Advent

Message: Do you know what I know... a child

December 23th

Theme Advent

Bible: Isaiah 11:1-4, 6-9, Luke 1:67-80

Message: Listen to what I say....pray for peace

Main Point: Peace is not so much the cessation of conflict but the active working of hope and love by each of us.

December 24th

Zion—5:00 Calvary—7:00

Theme: The Child, the Child

Bible: Various readings

Message: He will bring us goodness and light

Main Point: We believe in a God who comes to us and brings the gift of life.

Bible: Luke 2.22-38

Message: What happened a week later?

Main Point: Many meaningful events took place in the weeks following Jesus's birth. Gifts to be given, word of the arrival of the redeemer to be proclaimed in Jerusalem and Mary & Joseph's reflections.
