When the service is over the ushers will invite you to leave from the front of the Sanctuary and go out to the parking lot. Feel free to talk with each other outside but please do not stay in the fellowship room.

We have modified the seating so that you will be 6 feet apart.

There are some things we will not do for a while:

Shaking hands and passing of the peace.

Passing offering plates. You can put an offering in the basket on the table in the fellowship area. For a bit we will not sing the hymns. Singing causes the greatest amount of germs to be in the air.

Talking to each other in the fellowship room.

As I said it may not feel like worship as you recall worship yet the Spirit of God will be with us as we gather in Jesus name. The form of worship has changed throughout the years but the mighty acts of God are still told in each time and generation.
