Kathleen Finnerty of Sturgeon Bay is now at Ft McCoy volunteering her second two-week commitment. She is taking a carload of supplies each time she goes and will be going again in November. The sewing center is very busy, and the people are loving it. It helps them to help themselves. The Afghan women are making clothing for the men, women and children who left their homeland with almost nothing. Sewing supplies and sewing machines (in good working condition) are urgently needed. Below is a list of items needed for the Ft McCoy sewing kit. Any or all of the components are welcome, you do not have to supply all items for a kit.

1 spool white thread – minimum 300 yds

1 spool black thread – minimum 300 yds

1 pk sewing needles

1 1 pair sewing scissors – new or gently used

1 thimble – new or gently used

1 60" tape measure – new or gently used

8 buttons – neutral colors – new or gently used

4 safety pins – new or gently used


