July 7 at 5 pm Zion will be holding their first Hymn Sing of the season. The free will offering that they will be collecting will go to Habitat for Humanity. Please come and join us.

NOTE FROM CHARGE CONFERENCE

The 2024 Annual Conference was held June 7-10 at the KI Convention Center in Green Bay, WI. Around 8000 people attended. The theme of the session was "Abundant God, Beloved Community".

Bishop Jung welcomed Bishop Vedia of Bolivia. We have been in partnership with Bolivia for many years. Bishop Vedia sermon was "Jesus, the Way of Life and Love". As in tradition, the two bishops exchanged gifts. Bishop Jung was given a stole, purse and plaque.

During the Annual Conference four main workshops were held: Opening Workshop, Retiree Workshop, Memorial Worship and Ordination Service. Six New pastors were ordained for the Conference.

217 of the nearly 240 churches in the conference paid there 2003 apportionments in full. Both Calvary and Zion received tags to honor their 100% giving.

The 2024 budget was presented and approved. In 2023 many donations were received in addition to those in the 2023 budget. This included \$203,000 for UMCOR, \$142,000 for International Disaster Relief, \$156,000 for US Disaster Relief, and over \$12,000 for Ingathering. This year for Ingathering 1800 personal dignity kits, 170 Home Care Buckets,

school supplies, sleeping mats, medical equipment, bikes, sewing machines, cash and other items were collected at Annual Conference. (A truck and trailer were filled.)

During the Annual Conference much of the business was presented through video presentations, live speakers, and discussions. All action items presented to the members of the body present were voted on and passed. The presentations included camping, youth ministries, United Women in Faith, and Bishop Jung's trip to Bolivia. In 2025 Wisconsin will divided into 4 districts (presently 5), and the Northern Illinois Conference and the Wisconsin Conference will share a bishop.

The daily devotions were on "ABUNDANCE- having enough, not excess".

The banquet Sunday evening honored Bishop Hee-Soo Jung on his 12 years if service as the Bishop of the Wisconsin Conference. He and his wife Rev. Im Jung will be moving on to a new conference on September 1. (He won't know where until the middle of July). A seminary scholarship has been set up in his honor.
